^{*}Ermine Ameraucana/Olive Egger: The Ermine color is a project. The Ermine feather color does not breed true. Chicks hatched from these eggs may hatch Ermine, Black, or Dominant White. Ameraucana eggs may be blue or greenish blue. Ermine OE pullets will lay a variation of olive green. Available Summer 2025.

Note on Ayam Cemani and Silverudd's Blue: We no longer maintain a large breeding flock of these breeds. Our flocks are made up of our best young pullets and cockerels so the egg size is smaller than average. However, chicks have been hatching well out of these smaller eggs.

^{**}Buyer's Mix n Match Dozen: This dozen allows the buyer to pick which breeds he/she would like to make up a dozen eggs from what is available at the time. Limit of 2 eggs per dozen for each of the following breeds: Black Copper Marans, Indio Gigante, Ayam Ketawa, Liege Fighter, Silverudd's Blue, Ayam Cemani, and 55 Flowery Hen. Limit of 6 eggs each for all other breeds per dozen purchased. Ermine Ameraucana are excluded from this package.

^{***}Hen's Choice Assorted Dozen: This dozen may include eggs from any of our listed pure breeds and/or hybrids. We will choose the eggs for you. We will try to include at least 4 different breeds in this mix. No requests allowed.

^{****}Barnyard Mix Assorted Dozen: This is our cheapest package of hatching eggs and will consist mostly of barnyard mix eggs from our laying pens. Chicks may or may not be pure bred or mixed, mostly straight run, and will lay eggs of all different colors. If you're just looking for egg layers and do not care about the specific breed or egg color, this is the best option for you.
